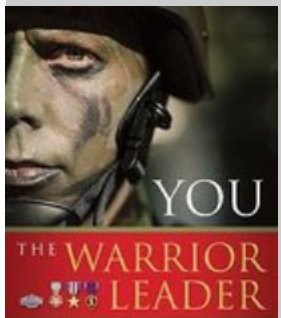

Dr. Welch is a native of Fort Payne, AL and Vietnam War hero. He was a U.S. Army paratrooper, Ranger, jungle expert and Green Beret. He was a highly decorated soldier, receiving the Bronze Star with "V" device for bravery, a Purple Heart, an Air Medal and Combat Infantryman Badge to mention only a few.

Dr. Welch pastored First Baptist Church of Daytona Beach from 1974-2006, is former President of the Southern Baptist Convention and presently serves as Strategist for Global Evangelical Relations with the SBC Executive Committee. He continues to passionately proclaim the message of soul winning, preaching in churches, conferences and convention meetings, nationally and internationally. He seeks to "continue the urging and encouraging cry, across the SBC as well as to other evangelicals, to equip, train, and mobilize our members to share the Gospel with their family and friends and people around the world."
